



1. A studio apprentice is soldering the window. New lead has been cut and the joints are being soldered with a 40/60 mix of lead and tin to bind the lead came together.



2. This window has been soldered at the joints.



3. This window has been cemented. This is the process of rubbing cement into the lead joints to strengthen the lead and bind the glass and new lead together.



4. An apprentice is "picking" the window. This process gets rid of excess cement on the glass and around the joints.



5. This is a completed window.
